Temporary Skill Shortage (Subclass 482)



This type of Visa enables employers to address labour shortages by bringing in skilled workers where employers can't source an appropriately skilled Australian worker. This is the most commonly used visa and has replaced the former '457 visa'

3 Eligibility Requirements

There are 3 main eligibility requirements to acquire TSS Subclass 482 Visa

1. LABOUR MARKET TESTING



Nomination applications associated with the subclass 482 visa are subject to the requirement of providing evidence of labour market testing (LMT). This needs to have been undertaken within the four month period immediately prior to lodging the nomination application.

- Occupations being sponsored on the Short-term stream will require IELTS of at least 4.5 in each test component or equivalent in PTE, TOEFL and OET. However, the Medium-term stream requires competent English (IELTS at least 5.0 in each test component or equivalent in PTE TOEFL and OET).
- English language exemptions will apply to people that fall into one of the following categories you are a passport holder from Canada, New Zealand, the Republic of Ireland, the United Kingdom or the United States of America



2. ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS



All applicants must have at least 2 years relevant work experience in your nominated occupation or a related field for the 482 visa. They may also need to have a relevant skills assessment if its deemed required by The Department for the specific occupation

3. TWO YEARS WORK EXPERIENCE
